Funeral Fund Policy and Directives

PAKISTANI AUSTRALIAN ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA

- Funeral Fund is for all Pakistani community members living in SA irrespective of the PAASA membership. It is not restricted to only PAASA financial members.
- Maximum \$3,000 will be used to pay off the funeral expenses from this fund at one occasion through cheque to the deceased's family.
- Approval of at least two members of the PAASA management committee will be required to issue the cheque.
- There will be 2 pathways for the amount to be given from this account. One is nonrefundable grant and other is amount given as loan.
- The requestor will be given both options and depending on the choice of the deceased family, the amount will be released.
- In case loan is requested from this account for the funeral, suitable time (not exceeding 06 months) will be given to return the loan to PAASA. If additional time is requested from the deceased family, same may be approved by managing committee.
- The maximum duration should not exceed 12 months including initial period.
- Cheque will be given to deceased family and receipt will be obtained for the amount released to the deceased family.
- The funeral fund form will be filled by the deceased family member or friend and forwarded to PAASA for approval for the release of funds. Funds cannot be released on verbal request.
- The funeral fund form may be asked by sending email to ec@paasa.org.au. In future the form may be available on PAASA website.
